Major: Geragogy (NEW)

Geragogy is an interdisciplinary form of education that combines the knowledge of pedagogy, psychology, medicine and social policy. This specialization was created in response to the existing social needs, according to statistics indicating the fact that populations across Europe are aging and human life expectancy is extending. As a result of demographic change will be created, more and more jobs for people who specialize in gerontology, and fewer for those who want to work with children and young people. Studies are aimed at people interested in the problems of the third age and / or working with seniors or wanting to expand their skills. Graduates of geragogy have a chance to find a job in nursing homes, day care homes, residential / municipal senior citizens clubs, cultural institutions and health centers in charge of its promotion or prevention for seniors, in projects aimed at the elderly.

Major: Sociotherapy

As part of this specialization graduate gains qualifications needed to get active methods in schools / educational institutions sociotherapeutic specialized classes for students with disabilities and disorders that hinder social functioning. These are among other: classes on addiction prevention, socio-therapeutic groups and educational development of children and youth, prevention activities on the various forms of violence.

Graduate will be able to find employment as a therapeutic teacher, therapeutic center employee, school and center - child care, emergency care, social welfare and act as coordinator sociotherapist in educational institutions.

Major: General Pedagogy

A graduate of the second degree study cycle has a sound theoretical interdisciplinary knowledge. The student has the ability to do research, and perform case study using scientific methods for theoretical and practical problems. The student is prepared to perform pro-social activities using self-improvement techniques. Studies in pedagogy prepare to work in various areas of educational activities in childcare centers, psychological-pedagogical centers, in schools and educational institutions, cultural animation, social welfare, health, the state and local administration institutions of justice and rehabilitation .Courses include:

cultural anthropology, logic, methodology of social research, andragogy, comparative pedagogy, pedeutology.

Major: Rehabilitation Pedagogy

A graduate of the second cycle receives Master's degree in education in the specialty of Rehabilitation pedagogy. Learning strategy during the study provides students with competences needed for supporting the development of pupils, individual approach to each of the pupils, constructing preventive and therapeutic programs and their implementation. Studies provide knowledge and expertise allowing the graduate to work in various areas of educational activities in childcare centers, psychological-pedagogical and other specialist clinics, social prevention institutions and centers.

Major: Health Promotion Pedagogy

Graduates majoring in health promotion gain knowledge of the principles and objectives of health education, including knowledge of basic elements of biomedical, psychological, sociological, educational and ecological health factors and their determinants. The graduates are prepared to work in kindergartens, schools, (counseling aimed at promoting health), educational institutions, specialist clinics, centers that promote health and social prevention centers, all types of sanitary-epidemiological stations, various health care facilities and types of rehabilitation plants of the disabled, social care facilities, hospices, health promotion centers.

Major: Early Child Development Support

Graduates have the ability to design and implement measures consistent with the early intervention program, child development, including the development of their talents. Studies are addressed to graduates in psychology (at the same time with pedagogical training) and pedagogical, who are working or preparing to work in kindergartens and schools (including integration) rehabilitation and educational centers, clinics and other institutions dealing with education and treatment of children with different kinds of developmental disorders, such as specific learning difficulties (e.g. developmental dyslexia), abnormal behavior (e.g. ADHD) or Pervasive Development Disorder (e.g. autism). The study program covers issues related to working with children of all ages and at every level of development.
